<ul> <li>Assess student injury.</li> <li>Send student to clinic.</li> <li>Sick Bay Data base to be updated, if required.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Assess student injury.</li> <li>Send for qualified person to assess student (if available)</li> <li>Office staff to inform parents of accident.</li> <li>Parents to pick up student if at all possible.</li> <li>If parents can't attend their instructions are to be followed.</li> <li>Supervising teacher to make follow-up phone call to family that night.</li> <li>Report to be filled in and a copy given to the AP. Sick Bay Data base to be updated.</li> <li>Level 2 injuries are to be reported to the Principal as soon as she is available</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Assess student injury.</li> <li>NEVER move the student.</li> <li>Call off the activity.</li> <li>Send for a qualified person to assess the student. (if available).</li> <li>Phone for a ambulance.</li> <li>Supervising Office Staff to contact the student's parents.</li> <li>Supervising teacher or designated staff member to travel to hospital either in ambulance or in own transport.</li> <li>Supervising teacher to remain at hospital with student until the parents arrive.</li> <li>Supervising teacher to make follow-up phone call to family that night.</li> <li>Accident report to be filled in and forwarded to CEO, and a copy to AP.</li> <li>Immediate report to the Principal</li> </ul>
