

Invitation for current HSC/Year 12 school students attending school in Bayside, Burwood and Strathfield Areas or living in Local Government Areas of concern to receive the COMIRNATY™ Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination.

NSW Health, Department of Education, Catholic Schools NSW and Association of Independent Schools NSW are working together to ensure HSC students who go to school in Bayside, Burwood or Strathfield Local Government Areas or live in any of the 12 Local Government Areas of concern are vaccinated as a priority group. The vaccination is one of the best ways to protect you against COVID-19 and reduce the transmission of the virus.

You are eligible for the vaccination if you are:

- Aged 16 years and above

AND

- Enrolled to sit one or more Higher School Certificate subjects (or otherwise completing year 12 in 2021) at a school or TAFE located in Bayside, Burwood or Strathfield Local Government Area **OR** have a permanent home address in Bayside, Blacktown, Burwood, Campbelltown, Canterbury-Bankstown, Cumberland, Fairfield, Georges River, Liverpool, Parramatta, Strathfield or Penrith but attend school elsewhere

If you are eligible, you will receive the COMIRNATY™ Pfizer vaccine and will require two doses of the vaccine 8 weeks apart. You must book both doses at the same location.

How to book

- (1) If you have a home address is within Bayside, Blacktown, Burwood, Campbelltown, Canterbury-Bankstown, Cumberland, Fairfield, Georges River, Liverpool, Parramatta, Strathfield or Penrith:**

You can choose the vaccination centre closest to you.

- (2) If your home address is outside one of the 12 LGAs of concern, but attend school in Bayside, Burwood or Strathfield Local Government Areas:**

You will need to register for Sydney Olympic Park Vaccination Centre and you will need to choose your school from a drop-down list to open priority appointments.

*Please be advised this invitation is for eligible students only and cannot be forwarded onto others.
Eligibility will be confirmed on the day of your appointment.*

If you or a household contact are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, you must not attend the vaccination appointment and speak with your school immediately. It is also important you get tested and self-isolate until you receive a negative test result.
