Dear Parents,

During Week 9-10 of Term 4 (29/11-8/12), our students in Year 10 will have the opportunity to participate in the Xavier Inquiry Learning module of 'My Pathway'. 'My Pathway' is designed to prepare your child for the learning and world beyond junior school. Students will have three pathways to choose from.

My Pathway One: Students will engage in Inquiry Projects from Cura Education which challenge them to connect to their future and community. The focus for this pathway will be twofold: Work Rules, and Making a Better World. In the Works Rules project students will explore the future of work and their place in it, possible career paths of interest, suitable university/training courses, and the steps needed to establish themselves in their future career. The second inquiry project is focused on Making a Better World. Students will collaborate to identify and design solutions to problems in today's world. They will develop competence in teamwork, critical thinking, and presentation skills.

Students will complete Pathway One <u>on campus</u> and be required to attend for the full duration of Week 9 and 10. <u>All students commencing their Senior studies at Xavier in 2022</u> are asked to commit to this pathway.

**My Pathway Two:** Students will engage in an Inquiry Project that prepares them to enter the workforce. Students will be required to write a resume, practice interview questions, and reflect on problem solving in the workplace. They will also research potential apprenticeship opportunities, job availability and training courses for their future job.

Students will complete Pathway Two <u>at home</u> and are required to be self directed in their learning using the modules set up on Google Classroom. They will have the opportunity for scheduled conferences with teachers involved in the project.

**My Pathway Three:** Students will form part of the Grounds Improvement Team. They will be performing jobs such as garden maintenance, cleaning, and various hands-on tasks.

Students completing Pathway Three will be <u>on campus</u> and required to wear appropriate gardening clothing.

All Year 10 students are invited to attend a Community Day on Thursday 9th December on campus until 12.30pm. Please indicate attendance via the <u>Google Form</u>.
