

Daily Playground Clean-Up Policy (Bins & Tidy up)

Preamble

Our policy on stewardship has its origins in Pope Francis' Encyclical Letter Laudato Si (Care for our Common Home).

In Section 43,

"Human beings are creatures of this world enjoying a right to /,fe and happiness, and endowed with unique dignity. We need to consider the effects on peoples lives on environmental deterioration and the throw away culture."

In Section 244,

"We come together to take charge of this home which has been entrusted to us knowing that all the good which exists here will be taken to the heavenly feast May our struggles and our concerns for our environment never take away our joy and hope."

Process

- This duty is conducted at the beginning of Learning Session 3.
- Each colour class in Years 7-10 will be rostered on for clean-up no more than 6 times per year. Each colour class misses no more than 30-minutes of a particular course per year during this duty.
- Students swap the full bins with the empty bins (using the map)
- Students complete a clean-up using buckets and tongs.
- Students wash their hands and then return to class.
