

Xavier College Mufti Day Attire / General Attire

Mufti/general attire is worn on specific occasions e.g. Year 12 retreat, field study, theatre excursions and mufti days at school.

- Students are to be neat and tidy.
- Shirts and outerwear must be of an acceptable length and size and are not to include T-Shirts with inappropriate expressions.
- No tops, which leave the **stomach area** or **lower back** exposed are to be worn.
- No singlet tops are to be worn. All students must wear sleeved shirts/blouses.
- Normal school bag.
- Closed in shoes must be worn no sandals or thongs (these are WH&S requirements and are not negotiable).
- No Shorts above the knee in length.
- No Leggings or tights are to be worn.
- Normal uniform expectations regarding hair, jewellery and makeup will be enforced.

Parents / Guardians need to be aware that students who attempt to wear clothing other than that deemed appropriate, will complete their learning in the Xavier Centre for the day or their parent/carer can drop off suitable clothing.

A note will be sent to parents and students on Compass detailing any specific changes for special occasion days.

Xavier College reserves the right to enforce these uniform guidelines and will make every effort to do so fairly and consistently.

Non-compliance with uniform rules will incur serious consequences.
